Student Presentation – 4th grade students Edith and Arabella presented their 3rd grade MDP year

Financial Report and Approval of Payments: Ms. Parrales guided the Board through the review of finances, LVDLCS's Balance Sheet at August 31st showed Cash (Checking Account + Investments) at \$3.1M, a decrease of \$266K since the end of the prior year (06/30/2023), along with an increase of \$379K in School District Receivables. The school's Fund Balance (Assigned + Unrestricted) at 08/31/23 has grown to \$3.4M+, while Accounts Payable is \$104K and Accrued Payroll is \$236K. For the 2 months ending 08/31/2023, the school has an operating surplus of \$268K, and its financial health metrics remain strong: Current Ratio = 4.1 (Standard = 1.1), Debt Ratio = 57.1% (Standard = <85%), Days COH = 77.5 (Standard = 60 Days).

Ms. Parrales called for a motion to approve the fiscal year financial report ending August 31, 2023 and for the list of bills to be paid. Motion was made by Mr. Lopez seconded by Ms. Weaver. Motion was passed unanimously.

Financial Statements

As of September 30, 2023

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Members of the Board of Trustees Lehigh Valley Dual Language Charter School

This Summary and Management Report presents information we believe is important to you as members of the school board. We encourage you to review the sections of this report and we would be pleased to furnish additional information as requested. Monthly financials are intended to provide a snapshot of the financials as of a specific point in time. As a result, they are subject to variances due to timing – the most common example is when invoices are received after the financials are prepared.

September Board Summary:

LVDLCS's Balance Sheet at September 30th showed Cash (Checking Account + Investments) at \$2.6M, a decrease of \$725K since the end of the prior year (06/30/2023), along with an increase of \$844K in School District Receivables. The school's Fund Balance (Assigned + Unrestricted) at 09/30/23 has grown to \$3.5M+, while Accounts Payable is \$89K and Accrued Payroll is \$175K. For the 3 months ending 09/30/2023, the school has an operating surplus of \$310K, and its financial health metrics remain strong: Current Ratio = 3.1 (Standard = 1.1), Debt Ratio = 59.9% (Standard = <85%). Days COH is 57.1 (just below the 60-day standard) as the school awaits the school district payments mentioned above.

1. Balance Sheet

- The school's combined Cash and Investment Balances were \$2,621,352 at September 30th, a decrease of \$724,658 from the prior year-end (6/30/2023) due to the delayed receipt of School District funds (payments were delayed in July-September by the PA Budget Impasse) and a decrease in Current Liabilities (see next bullet).
- Total Current Liabilities on September 30th, 2023 represent a \$447K decrease since June 30th due primarily to the reversal of Summer Payroll Accrual.
- The building purchase in August 2021 is reflected as a Fixed Asset (\$10M) and as a Liability (\$6.9M) on the Balance Sheet. Principal repayments are also shown on the Budget-to-Actual report in the Other Uses of Funds Debt Service section.

2. Budget to Actual for the Three (3) Months Ended September 30, 2023

- Total Revenues from Local School Districts of \$1,582,431 are under budget (by \$125K) as tuition invoices are still being paid at 22-23 rates through September. The school will also receive State and Federal grant funding, but these payments generally occur later in the fiscal year.
- Total Expenses of \$1,438,072 are below budget (by \$35K) at September 30th due to variances in Personnel Costs (+\$108K), Supplies (-\$59K), and Property Services (-\$83K).
- LVDLCS has opened FY24 (after three months of activity) with an Operating Surplus of \$310,051, a number that is likely to change as seasonal expense anomalies begin to normalize and as district payments start being calculated at 23-24 rates.

3. Charter Choices is Expanding Service Opportunities

What will change and what we're most excited about is that Charter Choices now has a "deep bench" for the additional services you have been asking for as well as thought partners for our leadership team to leverage as we continue to grow and improve our service delivery.
